

**CANOE RIVER AQUIFER ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES – June 3, 2010**

Minutes of the meeting held by the Canoe River Aquifer Advisory Committee on Thursday, June 3, 2010 beginning at 1 PM at the Norton Town Hall, first floor Conference/Break Room, Norton, MA.

- I. Call to Order** - Southworth called the meeting to order at 1:07 PM.
- II. Review Minutes of May 6, 2010** - Flynn/Potter moved to accept the minutes of May 6, 2010. VOTED
- III. Open Space Map & Greenbelt Update** - A rumor was heard that the Galloway Farm in Norton was up for sale and the sale fell thru; there is a new farm in Easton called “Langwater Farm”.
- IV. Recap 23rd Annual CRAAC Awareness Day – May 8, 2010** Southworth: had a decent turn out; weather did not cooperate as thunderstorms did not allow canoes to go out; next year will be out 24th. Suggestions for future awareness days: consider partnering with one of the Water Division’s open houses; have same in the fall (September/October) instead of the spring (originally picked spring for the water depth). It was noted that even some of the open houses do not get much people; nor have cookouts. Southworth – the thing that works well for Easton is the poster contest which people come for.

- VI. Vote to Suspend July 2010 Meeting** - Fowler/Potter moved to suspend the July meeting. VOTED

Guest Speaker George Yelle - History of the Canoe River** - Mr. Yelle gave an interesting slide show and talked about areas at or close to the Canoe River along with a history of development up to and including the construction of Route 495. His slides included early maps, excerpts from the Registry of Deeds, roadways, private homes and businesses which all emphasized the importance of the river in years gone by.
